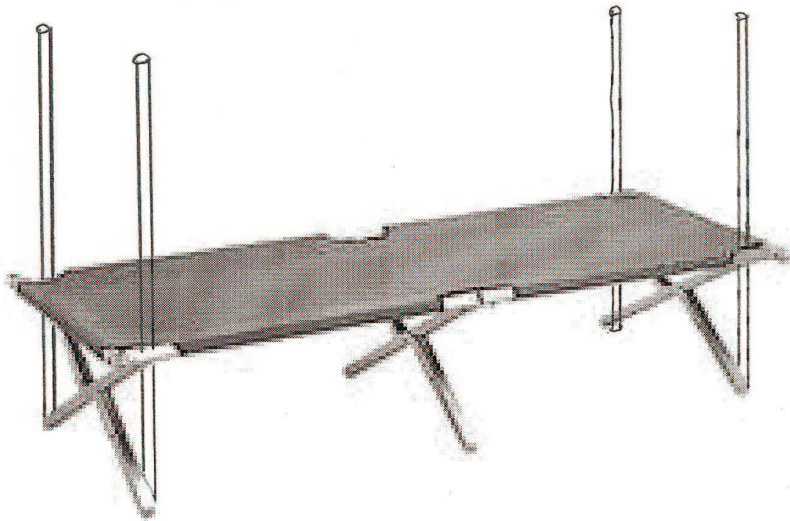
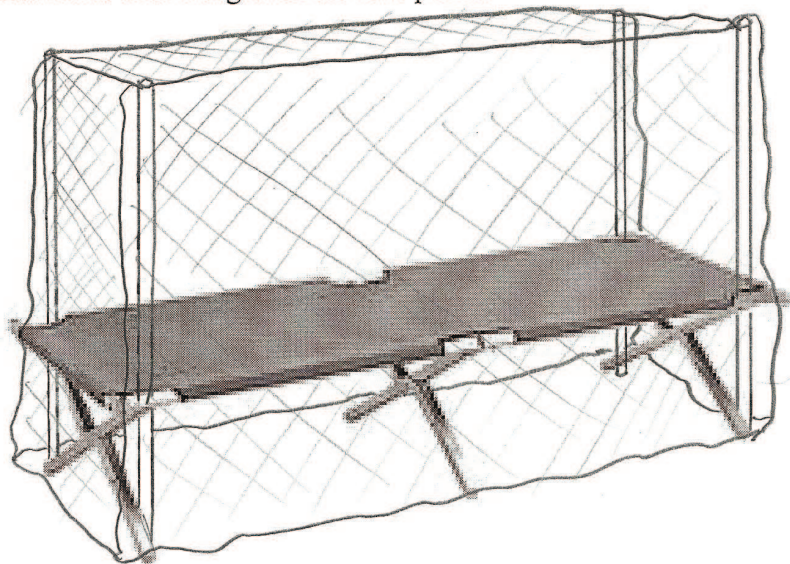


Mosquitoes at Owasippe are not typically a problem. Mosquito Netting is an optional item for scouts sleeping in Campaign tents. If you purchase mosquito netting, make sure you get the type of rectangular net that covers a typical camping cot (59"X32"X78"). These are typically available at most camping stores (Sports Authority, Dick's, Gander Mountain), on-line stores (Campmor) and sometimes WalMart or Target. They are usually about \$10.

The netting can be suspended by using four 48-inch poles made of doll rod or PVC pipe. If using PVC pipe, use $\frac{1}{2}$ inch diameter pipe. If using doll rod, use $\frac{3}{8}$ th inch diameter doll rod. The four poles are inserted at the ends of the cots and secured with Duck Tape.



The net is then hung over the four poles.



Make sure you write your son's name on his netting poles and secure them together with Duck Tape for the trip to Owasippe.
